



## Passive voice

#### When do we use it

- ❖ To form the passive, we use the appropriate tense of the verb to be + the past participle of the main verb.
- We use the passive when the action is more important than the agent(the person or thing doing the action). Salt was discovered.

(We are more interested in the action than the person who did it.)
